**Proposed Improvements to Public Footpath on Holly Avenue, Wilford Village**

The City Council are proposing to undertake improvements to the public footpath on Holly Avenue which is shown outlined in blue on the enclosed plan. Before we proceed with this, we would really like to hear your views. For example, do you think the footpath should be re-surfaced using black tarmac or should it have a more natural coloured surface or street lighting?

If you have an access gate from your garden onto the footpath, the improvements will not affect your access. Vehicles also use the footpath for private access to the allotments so the new surface of the footpath will have to be reasonably hard wearing. For this reason, a tarmac bonded surface or a similar bonded material would be better than loose crushed stone.

I have enclosed a short questionnaire which you may wish to use to indicate your preferences and then return it to me using the pre-paid envelope provided. The proposal will also be considered at the meeting of the Wilford Village Community Group at the Bowls Club, Main Road, Wilford Village, on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November at 7.30 p.m. You are more than welcome to attend.
